DIAGNOSE

There are several possible ways staining occurs in pools. The Stain Drop S.R.V. Kit contains the tools to help determine which particular stain is in your pool and how to treat it.

With the water still, above 60° F, and balanced*, a portioned amount of each product(s) is poured directly onto the pool stain. Stains in the deep end? The S.R.V. Kit includes the tools to help treat in those difficult to diagnose areas without having to dive into the pool.

REMOVE

The Stain Drop S.R.V. Kit helps to determine your treatment options, which include:



STAIN DROP NO. 1

Removes stains caused by iron and tannins (leaves, acorns, branches, etc.).

STAIN DROP NO. 2

Removes stains caused by copper and scale.



STAIN DROP NO. 3

Oxidizes copper to help remove embedded copper stains.

SPOT STAIN CHALK

Stain-removal chalk is a blend of powerful stain removers in a handy block. Use to scrub off stains or place on stubborn stains to lighten or remove stains. Works on surface stains above and below the water.



REMOVE OPEN PREVENT

After a stain has been removed, the stain causing particles need to be trapped in solution. Doing so prevents formation of new stains in the same or in new spots around the pool.

STAIN DROP offers the industry's most powerful liquid product. It traps metals in source water, and sequesters metals lifted during the stain removal process.

STAIN DROP ALL PURPOSE XpH

is phosphate free and works in any pH environment. This product traps a variety of metals and scale-producing elements. Ideal for both prevention and light stain removal.
